You need a system for analyzing texts and organizing them for teaching your small groups. My favorite leveling system is the Fountas & Pinnell text level gradient – also called the guided reading levels. Let ' s look at how these levels correspond to different grade levels in K-3.

Level 1: BEGINNING READING Short sentences, familiar words, and simple concepts for children eager to read on their own. This level is just right for readers who are beginning to sound out words and sentences. Books on this level, like Danny and the Dinosaur, are written with simple sentences using familiar words.

Guided reading is used in the classroom for small-group instruction. When your child enters a new grade, he or she is assessed and assigned a guided reading level based on word knowledge, comprehension, and fluency. The levels range alphabetically from A to Z, with level A representing the lowest level and level Z the highest.
